Itinerary

Day 1 - Welcome to Israel!

- * **ANU Museum** of the Jewish People: a cutting-edge museum, recently gut-renovated to tell the story of the Jewish People from biblical to the present time, wherever they reside.
- * Walk along the vibrant Carmel food Market, the biggest Shuk (marketplace) in Tel Aviv.

* Graffiti tour - tour through Tel Aviv's alleys and markets in search for the unique graffiti that is scattered

around the city. Learn about the artists and their art, their protest and their messages.

- * **Peres Center** Discover the incredible story of Israel, the Innovation nation, through a fascinating journey inspired by the vision of President Shimon Peres!
- * Evening Lecture by **Einat Wilf** (former Israeli politician and the writer of "The war of return") Introduction to Israel, the conflict and future solutions.

Day 3 - Otef Aza and Re'im Forest

Thu, December 4, 2025

* Breakfast at your hotel.

Embark on an excursion to the south, to witness and remember the horrors of October 7th.

- * **Kibbutzim Be'eri** one of the most ravaged kibbutzim of October 7th and the kibbutz with which Temple Sinai has partnered to rebuild and support.
- * **Tekuma** where the burnt and bullet-ridden cars of the victims, as well as the terrorist pick-up trucks, have been placed, and is currently a memorial site.
- * **Re'im Forest** the site where the Nova music festival took place and is now a memorial for the victims who participated in the festival.
- * Return to Tel Aviv.
- * Overnight: Tel Aviv

- * Breakfast at your hotel & Check out.
- * Meet with **Dr. Ofrit Shapira-Berman**, a psychoanalyst and a professor at Jerusalem's Hebrew University. She has been working very closely with the families of hostages and other victims of October 7th, and will help illuminate different aspects of the healing process as well as the still-unfolding trauma.
- * Meeting with **HaShomer HaChadash** (The New Guardian, one of the most successful Zionist organizations) / **Achim Laneshek** (Brothers and Sisters in Arms) The lead organization that helped civilians and soldiers at the beginning of the war until now.



* Home hospitality dinner at Gadi and his wife Adi (Yesod Hama'ala).

Day 5 - The Golan Heights

Sat, December 6, 2025

- * Breakfast at your hotel.
- * Jeep tour along the Syrian border with Captain (Res.) Ilan Shulman. Ilan is one of the leading speakers about the Syrian Israeli relationship. He is one of the foremost experts in Israel due to his reserve duty and life in the kibbutz on the border.
- * Visit the **Druze Village Majdal Shams**, the community that lost 12 kids from Hizballah rocket. Enjoy local and traditional food at one of the local houses.
- * Chateau Golan visit & wine tasting in their magnificent wine cave, the site where Rabbis Natan and Sam had their Israeli wedding reception.

- * Tour of the **Temple Mount**: a site usually overlooked by visitors but one that stands at the center of the

biblical story. The place where once stood the first and the second holiest site to Islam.

- * Tour of the phenomenal and brand-new **National Library of Israel**, a must-see and fascinating site that tells the rich story of Jewish Peoplehood.
- * Jerusalem Security fence tour with Col. Dr. Dany Tirza, an expert in the field of strategic planning, Homeland security, demarcation, and border security.
- * Meet with **Gush Etzion residents**, including home hospitality dinner.

Payment Terms

\$500 per person non-refundable deposit by September 1^{st} , 2025. Final balance is due 60 days prior to arrival.

Cancellations effective upon receipt of written notification are subject to the following penalties of the full trip price:

- \$500 per person non-refundable deposit by September 1st, 2025.
- September 1st, 2025 31 days prior to arrival: 50% penalty.
- o 30-15 days prior to arrival: 75% penalty.
- 14 days prior to arrival: 100% penalty.

In case of force majeure (either in Israel or in the traveler's country of origin) such as government actions, natural disaster, security situation, pandemic, the traveler may postpone their trip to any given time within 18 months and have the amount paid until that point saved in full as credit for the future trip. In case the traveler does not wish to postpone for a later date, they may cancel the trip at a fee of \$500 per person or 5% of the tour's total cost – the higher of the two.
